Fun with Watercolours Supply List

- Watercolour Paints – professional artist quality paint is preferred (Leslie uses Winsor & Newton). Only three colours will be used:
 - Aureolin OR Cadmium Yellow Light
 - Permanent Alizarin Crimson OR Permanent Rose
 - Prussian OR Antwerp Blue
- Brushes – please bring what you have to use. Leslie prefers a kolinsky sable in size #6 or #8. Also bring an old brush to mix paints.
- Paper – please bring two sheets of Arches watercolour paper (22x30) and some sketch/tracing paper. Please bring a board to attach a half sheet of paper and some tape or clip to attach it with.
- Palette
- Three small containers with lids to mix your colours in
- Winsor & Newton masking fluid (new bottle)
- Water container
- Apron/smock
- Spray bottle
- Pencil and eraser
- Paper towels
- Lightweight travel easel (optional, but we may have the opportunity to paint outside)
- Transfer paper (optional)
